### **Training & Education Services**

Compassionate care from trained foster families & professionals is crucial to the restoration process. Our state-accredited training prepares foster families, individuals, and industry professionals for the realities they will face while working with sex trafficked child survivors.

# **Restoration Therapy Services Program**

Blanket Fort Hope provides restoration therapy services to trafficked minors who are put in our care. Boys and girls who've experienced these horrors need specialized therapy to help them cope with their past and move on to their future. We are a licensed Child Placement Agency (CPA) and can manage the recovery of child trafficked survivors and guide them to heal.



#### **Trauma Training Center**

The Trauma Training Center will serve children and families directly through intake, visitation, and therapeutic services, while also equipping law enforcement and community partners with trauma-informed training that improves safety, reduces escalation, and prevents re-traumatization. By aligning agencies around best practices, we help ensure child survivors receive a coordinated, compassionate, child-centered response.
